### JOHNSON COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT H1N1 CLINIC CLOSED

(OLATHE, KS – NOV. 2, 2009) The Johnson County Health Department administered 657 vaccinations today to individuals in the high priority groups identified by the CDC.

The Health Department has now administered all of the H1N1 flu vaccine that had been reserved for a public clinic. There are no other public clinics scheduled at this time.
